Max\* is 78 and a client of two senior programs at Catholic Charities: Connections & Awareness for Elders (CAFE) and the RepPayee program. CAFE has volunteers who provide a connection to isolated older adults. Max is a widower. The stress has left him unable to manage his bills and checks. The RepPayee program assists seniors in paying bills and managing their Social Security benefits. Max started the service two years ago. He feels less stressed than ever now that he has someone to help him with his bills.

**CHOOSE LIFE:** In vitro fertilization deserves a closer look. "Life



is created in a lab as a commodity, a product. The faulty premise of in vitro fertilization is that 'I have a right to have a baby,'" explains noted bioethicist, Fr. Tad Pacholczyk. During the course of in vitro fertilization, many eggs become fertilized but only some are implanted. Of those, some may be selectively aborted to avoid a multiple pregnancy.
